Hollywood Exchange – Belfast & Eastern Council Area

I understand that the Boundary Commission will be considering the future boundary of the land between Hollywood and Belfast in the very near future. I would wish you to record this Chamber of Commerce's views that the landed estate known as Hollywood Exchange should be defined as being within the borough known as East. This is in support of the request made by North Down Borough Council.

This Chamber of Commerce has been forging close links with the various businesses positioned in the Hollywood Exchange area. The larger businesses within Hollywood Exchange have assisted with funding bodies such as the Hollywood Arts Trust and sponsorship of events such as the Hollywood Jazz Festival and the Hollywood Music Week.

It is this Chambers mandate to develop and promote the business community and those businesses at Hollywood Exchange took on the Hollywood name in support of the links created. As this has been operating for some 5 years it would be a tremendous shame if the strength of the relationship were undermined by the Commissions action. Instead we would wish to see it strengthened by being officially included within the Eastern Borough. This would improve civic identity and consolidate the business community that unfortunately rarely gets heard in such circumstances.
